The songs, recorded live and primarily with acoustic instruments, are by turns jubilant, defiant, loving and proud. They hark back to the timeless sounds of people living and working together; the field hollers, the campfire songs, the soft prayers - bringing their stories to life via natural imagery and vivid detail.
